DESCRIPTION OF VOLUNTEER WORK

We need volunteers to drive and assist consumers to our support group which meets on the first and third Thursdays from 11 to 12:30. This would be a once a week or every other week commitment, at a time that suits the volunteer and the consumer.

What skills should this volunteer have?

Volunteers would need a clean driver's license if they are driving consumers. They would also need to have a caring and friendly personality, and a willingness to listen and communicate with elderly people.

Does your organization have a formal Volunteer Intake Process or Volunteer Application to be completed? Yes. Volunteers need to complete a brief application including references. There is a one hour orientation to the agency and working with individuals who are blind.
